DEVELOPING NATURE-BASED SOLUTIONS FOR DECARBONIZATION

AMF boast extensive expertise in conducting forestry studies, supported by a dedicated team of forestry engineers and carbon specialists. We have been collaborating with the School of Life Science and Technology Bandung Institute of Technology (SITH ITB) since 2022 through Quintuple Helix Co-Laboratory in Ecosystem Services Management to Build Resilience Capacity to develop a forest restoration and sustainable community development program in Special Purpose Forest Areas Gunung Geulis. Beyond, we work jointly with the SITH ITB experts in performing forestry works, including carbon offset projects in forestry.

AMF work with the **Indonesia Coral Reefs Foundation (TERANGI)** in blue carbon initiatives by unlocking blue carbon value with solid governance and capacity sharing. This creates sustainable financing due to social economic diversification for the management of marine protected areas.


